

Christmas Time in Brussels (4 days)



Day 1: Brussels

Arrival to Brussels, the capital of European union! The town of chocolate and mussels, waffles and beer is marvelous around Christmas time, showing its charm in full with all its magnificent historical buildings beautifully lit and streets filled with intriguing Christmas markets, handicraft, food and drink! Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 2: Brussels

After breakfast we start a full day guided tour of the city! The marvelous Grand Place (listed as UNESCO World Heritage), the famous Manneken Pis-statue, the Royal Palace of Brussels, Church "Notre Dame au Sablon" and Place du Grand Sablon with its many art galleries and chocolateries (time for a bit of chocolate shopping), Place du Saint Catherine where the

biggest and most spectacular Christmas markets in town is situated and much much more... Free time for lunch during the guided tour (in some of the recommended restaurants) in the Rue des Bouchers, a spectacle worth seeing whether you are hungary or not. The small street is bursting with restaurants with fancy seafood displays like art works by the front doors and tables outside all year round. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 3: Brussels

Free day to explore the attractive Christmas markets and the city individually. Try the famous Belgian mussels and beer in one of the small restaurants, stop for a cup of coffee in the elegant cafes of the town and for those who are curious about the famous Belgian chocolate, there is the House of

Belgian Chocolate Masters at the Grand Place to be visited. Explore some of the museums of galleries, which there are plenty in Brussels, do some Christmas shopping or just the sights and vibrant and festive atmosphere of the city. Dinner and overnight in hotel.
