

Germany Rhine Tour (5 days)



Day 1: Heidelberg

Heidelberg is world famous for its romantic castle and its picturesque Old Town with its winding alleys steeped in history. In the afternoon you will have a guided city tour. You visit the gate of the medieval bridge, the main square, the famous fountain of Sebastian Münster, the Boissereè palace, the church Heiliggeist and much more. Dinner and overnight in hotel including breakfast.

Day 2: Heidelberg – Cologne - Düsseldorf

Today, you will visit the cities of Cologne and Bonn during a full day tour. Cologne (Köln) is one of Germany's most original cities, with its twin-spired cathedral, its romantic Rhine panorama and its rich combination of modern lifestyle with 2,000 years of historical and cultural heritage. The former federal capital Bonn is known for its cultural highlights, numerous museums and castle

Medinghofen. Dinner and overnight in hotel in Düsseldorf including breakfast

Day 3: Cruise on Rheine

The section between Bingen and Koblenz is called "The Romantic Rhine" and the beautiful landscape in this area explains why; heavily wooded valleys and vineyards clinging to the steep slopes accompany your every step and castles appear at every turn of the river. After the cruise, you will go back to Düsseldorf. Dinner and overnight in hotel including breakfast.

Day 4: Düsseldorf - Strasbourg

Today you will go to the French city of Strasbourg which is situated provocatively on the Franco-German border and has been passed back and forth over the centuries between these two countries like a ping-pong ball. Dinner and overnight in hotel in Strasbourg including breakfast.

Day 5: Strasbourg

The Grande Ile (Big Island) is the heart of the city, encircled by the Ill River and Fossé du Faux-Rempart canal. During your guided tour you will see the most important sights of Strasbourg such as Cathédrale Notre-Dame, place Kléber, place Gutenberg, the main streets (rue des Grandes Arcades and the parallel rue des Francs Bourgeois) and Strasbourg's medieval quarter which is classed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.
